A local law known as A Local Law to Amend Tax Exemption Limits for Persons Over 65 Years of Age in the Town of Kendall

SECTION 1. Statutory authority.

This article is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law and the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 2. Exemption Amount

Pursuant to the provisions of § 467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the income eligibility levels for determining qualification for the partial exemption from real property taxes for persons 65 years of age and older are hereby established in accordance with the following schedule:

Annual Income	Partial Tax Exemption
\$0 to \$19,000.00	50%
\$19,000.01-\$19,999.99	45%
\$20,000.00-\$20,999.99	40%
\$21,000.00-\$21,999.99	35%

\$22,000.00-\$22,899.99	30%
\$22,900.00-\$23,799.99	25%
\$23,800.00-\$24,699.99	20%
\$24,700.00 and over	0%

SECTION 3. Repealer

Sections 217-4 and 217-5 of the Code of the Town of Kendall, together with Local Law 2 of 2014 as adopted by the Kendall Town Board on August 19, 2014, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 4.

(a) This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.

(b) If any part or section of this local law shall be held to be invalid, the remaining provisions thereof shall not fail but shall remain in full force and effect.

(c) All local laws, ordinances, rules or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any portion of this local law are hereby repealed.
