Property Taxes

The 2025 Tax bills due by April 30th. Payment is available at 1873 Kendall rd in the town of Kendall, Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, from 9:00am to noon and 1:00pm to 3:30PM, and Mondays from 7:00pm until 9:00pm, for the purpose of receiving taxes. Taxes may also be deposited into the drop box to the left of the front door of the town hall. Taxes can also be mailed to Tax collector, P.o. Box 474 Kendall, ny 14476.

SEWER DISTRICT UPDATE

The Town of Kendall will not require homeowners with existing septic systems to connect to the new sewer system. Thereafter, homeowners may maintain their septic systems and undertake minor repairs that do not require OCHD permits. However, if an existing septic system requires repair or replacement for which a permit from OCHD is required, no permit will be issued by Orleans County Health Department, (OCHD), and the homeowner will be required to connect to the sewer system at their own cost and expense. In that event, the septic system would need to be fully decommissioned at the homeowner's sole cost and expense as well – a cost which would otherwise be borne by the sewer district if the homeowner connects when construction occurs. Accordingly, there are significant advantages to connecting to the new sewer system now compared to waiting.



Curtis Park Update

Water District 11:

Well testing is a requirement from USDA for grant and loan dollars from them. Orleans County no longer does well testing. The Town Board will hire LaBella Associates to perform the tests and forward the results to Orleans County Health Department for their review and a letter of recommendation from them to USDA. This expense is a reimbursable expense which is covered back to the town from USDA. We are moving forward in our progress for a 5th water district to our residents.

Kendall Residents Needed for Project Advisory Committee
The Town of Kendall received a Smart Growth Community Planning Program Grant from the New York State Department of State to prepare a Town of Kendall Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan. The Town's Comprehensive Plan was last updated in 1997 and significant changes in land use (e.g., solar farm installations, Troutburg Planned Unit Development), school population and resident demographics have occurred since then.

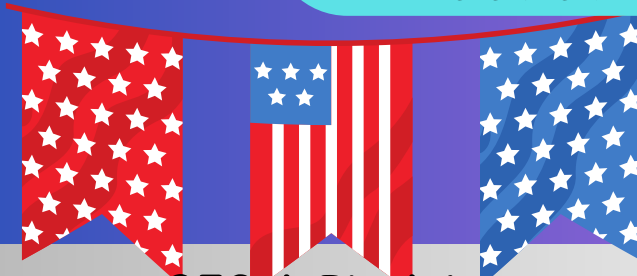
Kendall was also awarded a grant from the New York State Department of Agriculture & Markets for preparation of an Agricultural and Farmland Protection Plan. Kendall is primarily an agricultural community which means this plan will be an important component of the overall comprehensive plan.

The Town Board will engage a consulting firm to guide the overall process. It will also establish a Project Advisory Committee to oversee the plan development in cooperation with Kendall elected officials, other Kendall boards, and community members. This Project Advisory Committee will have a diverse range of stakeholders and will include at least one member from the Kendall Planning Board, as well as farmers, business owners, and residents from a range of ethnic, social, and cultural backgrounds.

Kendall is requesting resident participation as members of this Project Advisory Committee. The Committee will help guide the planning process, participate in meetings, generate ideas and build consensus, and provide the consultant team with relevant information reflecting the community's current condition and needs.

They will also provide feedback on materials drafted by the consultant team, support public participation and outreach efforts, and set the stage for the plan's implementation. If you are interested in participating in this important process please contact:

From the Pages of a Suspenseful Mystery to the Small Screen

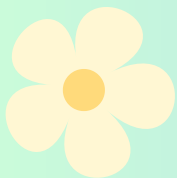
If you have streamed "Bosch" or "Bosch: Legacy" on Prime or Freevee and haven't read the books by Michael Connelly, the series are based on about veteran L.A. Police detective Harry Bosch. Harry is a tenacious, homicide detective, who refuses to give up until he has solved the case. His determination to get justice for the victims no matter who they are often leads him into conflict with his bosses, but as Harry says "Everyone counts or noone counts." It doesn't matter to him whether the victims or suspects are rich and influential or homeless.

If you like a lot of action with your mysteries, "Reacher" on Prime might be for you. Based on the books by Lee Childs, Jack Reacher is a retired military policeman. He has become a vagabond, riding the bus to wherever it goes around the country with the clothes on his back and a toothbrush in his pocket. He frequently finds himself embroiled in rescuing people caught up in complicated situations. When he sees an in justice, he just can't walk away, even if he only intended to get off the bus for a cup of coffee. He becomes a one man army that doesn't flinch from violence.

Don't subscribe to Prime? That's okay. Come and sign the books out of the Kendall Town Library and enjoy these characters and twisty-turny stories. I always like the books better than the movies anyway. - Eileen in the Library

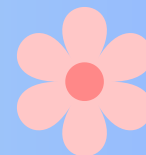
